Agreement between the United Kingdom and Greece respecting the Measurement of Tonnage of Merchant Ships.

Signed at London, November 30, 1926.

His Britannic Majesty's Government and the Greek Government have agreed as follows:—

In view, of the fact that the existing laws and regulations of ; Great Britain in regard measurement of tonnage of merchant ships are in substantial agreement with those of Greece, British ships furnished certificates of registry and other national papers duly issued by the competent British authorities shall be deemed by the Greek authorities to be of the tonnage denoted in the said documents, and shall be exempted from being remeasured in any port or place within Greek territory or in localities under the control of Greece, on condition that similar terms shall be accorded to Greek ships equipped with certificates of registry or other national papers duly issued by the competent Greek authorities on or after the 14th July, 1909 (o.s. 1st July, 1909), and that such ships shall be exempted from being-remeasured in any place within His Britannic Majesty's Dominions or under His

Η Κυβέρνησις της Ελληνικής Δημοκρατίας καὶ ή Κυβέρνησις της Αυτού Βρεττανικής Μεγαλειότητος συνεφώνησαν τὰ εξης:

'Ως έκ του γεγονότος ότι οι έν Μεγάλη Βρεττανία ισχύοντες ώς πρός τὴν καταμέτρησιν τῆς είς τόννους χωρητικότητος των έμπορικῶν πλοίων Νόμοι καὶ Κανονισμοί συμφωνούσι κατ' οὐσίαν μετά τῶν Νόμων καὶ Κανονισμῶν τῶν ίσχυόντων έν Έλλάδι, άγγλικά πλοία, εφωδιασμένα δια πιστοποιητικών νηολογήσεως και άλλων έγγράφων Έθνικότητος, διόντως έκδεδομένων ύπο τῶν άρμοδίων Βρεττανικών Αρχών, θὰ θεώρωνται ὐπὸ των Ἑλληνικων Αρχων ώς έχοντα την χωρητικότητα, την αναφερομένην είς τα προμνησθέντα ἔγγραφα καὶ θ΄ άπαλλάσσωνται νέας καταμετρήσεως είς οιονδήποτε λιμένα ή τμημα του ελληνικου εδάφους, η είς περιοχήν ύπο την έλληνικήν κυριαρχίαν, ύπὸ τὸν ὅρον ὅτι αἰ αὐταὶ ἐὐκολίαι θὰ παραχωρώνται εις Ελληνικά πλοιά, εφωδιασμένα δια πιστοποιητκού νηυλογήσεως η ἄλλων Έγγράφων Έθνικότητος, δεύντως έκδεδομένων ύπο τω ν άρμοδίων Έλληνικων Άρχων ἀπὸ

Britannic Majesty's protection or control.

Either of the contracting parties may, on giving to the other twelve months' notice to that effect, terminate this Agreement either as a whole or separately in respect of any of the following parts of His Britannic Majesty's Dominions, viz., the Dominion of Canada, the Commonwealth of Australia, the Dominion of New Zealand, the Union of South Africa, the Irish Free State, Newfoundland, and His Majesty's Indian Empire.

In the event of the Agreement being terminated in respect of any such part of His Britannic Majesty's Dominions, the Agreement shall cease to apply to British ships registered therein.

In witness whereof, the undersigned have signed the present Agreement and have affixed thereto their seals.

"Εκαστον τω ν συμβαλλομένων Μερών δύναται, προειδοποιούν πρός τούτο τὸ ἔτερον Μέρος δώδεκα μήνας πρότερον, νὰ τερματίση την παρούσαν Συμφωνίαν, είτε εξ όλοκλήρου, είτε χωριστά, υσον άφορφ οιανδήποτε έκ των κατωτέρω αναφερομένων Κτήσεων τῆς Α. Βρεττανικῆς Μεγαλειότητος, ήτοι του Καναδάν, την 'Ομοσπονδιακήν Πολιτείαν τῆς Αυστραλίας, την Νέαν Ζηλανδίαν, την "Ενωσιν της Νοτίου Αφρικης, τὸ Ίρλανδικὸν Έλεύθερον Κράτος, την Νέαν Γην, ώς και τὸ Ίνδικὸν Κράτος τῆς Α. Μεγαλειότητος.

Εν περιπτώσει καθ ην η Συμφωνία ήθελε τερματισθή ώς προς οἰονδήποτε τοιούτον Τμήμα τών Κτήσεων της Α. Βρεττανικής Μεγαλειότητος, η Συμφωνία δέν θὰ ἰσχύμ έπὶ Βρεττανικών πλοίων νηολογημένων εἰς τὸ ἐν λόγω τμήμα.

Είς πίστωσιν τω ν ανωτέρω, οὶ ύπογεγραμμένοι ύπέγραψαν την παρούσαν Σύμβασιν καὶ ἐπέθηκαν τὰς ἐαυτω ν σφραγίδας.

Sir Austen Chamberlain to M. Caclamanos.

Sir, Foreign Office, November 30, 1926.

With reference to the Agreement which is being signed this day on behalf of the British and Greek Governments in regard to the measurement of tonnage of merchant ships, I desire to place on record the fact that this agreement is made with the consent of His Majesty's Self-governing Dominions and India.

2. I have the honour to add that it would be understood that the stipulations of the Agreement shall not be applicable to Iraq unless notice shall have been given of the desire of the Iraq Govern-

ment that they shall be so applicable.
