Berne, 10th March, 1951.

In accordance with instructions received from His Britannic Majesty's Principal Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs, I have the honour to propose that the Monetary Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Swiss Government, signed in London on 12th March, 1946,(1) as extended and modified by the Exchanges of Notes between those Governments on 25th February/3rd March, 1949,(2) 4th March, 1950,(3) and 10th November, 1950,(4) shall be extended for a further period of three months from 11th March, 1951.

If the Swiss Government agree to this proposal, I have the honour to suggest that the present Note and your reply in that sense shall be regarded as constituting an Agreement between the two Governments.
