His Majesty's Chargé d'Affaires at Berne to the Delegate of the Swiss Federal Council for Commercial Agreements

British Legation.

I have the honour, upon instructions from His Majesty's Principal Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs, to propose that the Monetary Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Swiss Government, of 12th March, 1946,(1) as extended and modified by the Exchanges of Notes between those Governments of 25th February and 3rd March, 1949,(2) of 4th March, 1950,(3) 10th November, 1950,(4) and 10th March 1951,(5) shall be extended for a further period of four months from 11th June, 1951.

If the Swiss Government agree to this proposal I have the honour to suggest that the present Note and your reply in that sense shall be regarded as constituting an agreement between the two Governments.
