I have the honour to propose that the Monetary Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Swiss Government of 12th March, 1946,<sup>(1)</sup> as prolonged and modified by the Exchanges of Notes between those Governments of 25th February, 1949/3rd March, 1949,<sup>(2)</sup> 4th March, 1950,<sup>(3)</sup> 10th November, 1950,<sup>(4)</sup> 10th March, 1951,<sup>(5)</sup> 9th June, 1951,<sup>(6)</sup> 2nd October, 1951,<sup>(7)</sup> and further prolonged until 11th May, 1952, by an Exchange of Notes between the two Governments of 24th March, 1952,<sup>(6)</sup> shall be deemed to have continued in force after 11th May and shall remain in force until 30th June, 1952.

If the Swiss Government agree to this proposal, I have the honour to suggest that the present Note and your reply in that sense shall be regarded as constituting an agreement between the two Governments.
