The Finnish Minister at London to the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs

Finnish Legation, London,

Your Excellency, 7th July, 1952.

I have the honour to propose that the Sterling Payments Agreement between the Government of Finland and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, signed in London on 7th July, 1950,(1) shall be prolonged for a period of three months after 7th July, 1952:

2. If the Government of the United Kingdom agree to this proposal, I have the honour to suggest that the present Note and your reply to that effect shall be regarded as constituting an Agreement between the Governments.
