EXCHANGE OF NOTES BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK REPUBLIC EXTENDING THE STERLING PAYMENTS AGREE-MENT OF 18th AUGUST, 1949, AS AMENDED BY EXCHANGE OF NOTES OF 28th DECEMBER, 1950.

The Czechoslovak Ambassador at London to the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs

Czechoslovak Embassy,

Sir,
The Sterling Payments Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Czechoslovak Republic and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, signed in London on the 18th August, 1949(1), and amended by an Exchange of Notes on the 28th December, 1950(2), is due to expire on the 19th August, 1952. I have the honour to propose that this Agreement shall, unless previously terminated by notice given in accordance with Article X, continue in force for a period of three years after the 19th August, 1952.

If the Government of the United Kingdom agree to this proposal, I have the honour to suggest that the present Note and your reply to that effect shall be regarded as constituting an Agreement between the two Governments.

I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of your Excellency's Note of to-day's date proposing that the Sterling Payments Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Czechoslovak Republic, signed in London on the 18th August, 1949, and amended by an Exchange of Notes of the 28th December, 1950, shall, unless previously terminated by notice given in accordance with Article X, continue in force for a further period of three years after the 19th August, 1952.

In reply, I have the honour to inform your Excellency that the Government of the United Kingdom accept this proposal of the Government of the Czechoslovak Republic, and will regard your Note and this reply as constituting an Agreement between the two Governments.
