I have the honour to propose that the Sterling Payments Agreement between the Government of the Polish People's Republic and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland signed in London on 2nd March, 1948,(1) and last prolonged until the 9th March, 1954,(2) in accordance with an Exchange of Notes between the two Governments, shall be deemed to have continued in force after 9th March, 1954, and shall remain
