Bangkok, April 5, 1954.

I have the honour to refer to the Air Services Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Kingdom of Thailand signed at Bangkok on the 10th of November, 1950,(¹) and to inform your Royal Highness that the Government of the United Kingdom propose that Route I of Section I of the Schedule of Routes annexed to that Agreement should be amended to read as follows:—

If this proposal is acceptable to the Royal Thai Government, I have the honour to suggest that this Note and your Royal Highness's reply in that sense should be regarded as constituting an agreement between the two Governments in this matter which shall enter into force immediately.
