The Norwegian Minister for Foreign Affairs to Her Majesty's Ambassador at Oslo

Ministère Royale des Affaires Etrangères,

Oslo, 29 August, 1955. Herr Ambassadör. Jeg har den ære å vise til avtalen mellom Kongeriket Norges regjering og Det Forente Kongerike Storbritannia og Nord-Irlands regjering om luftruter mellom og forbi deres respektive territorier undertegnet i London den 23. juni 1952, og å foreslå at rute (2) i Liste I til vedlegget til denne avtale endres til å lyde som fölger:---

I norsk tekst:

2. Punkter i Storbritannia-Stavanger-Bergen-Oslo-Stockholm.

I engelsk tekst:

(2) Points in the United Kingdom-Stavanger-Bergen-Oslo-Stockholm.

Hvis detter forslag godtas av Det Forente Kongerikes regjering, har jeg den ære å foreslå at denne note og Deres Eksellenses bekreftende svar skal ansees som en avtale mellom våre to regjeringer, som skal tre i kraft straks.

Herr Ambassadör,

Royal Ministry for Foreign Affairs,

Oslo, 29th August, 1955. I have the honour to refer to the Agreement between the Government of the Kingdom of Norway and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland for Air Services between and beyond their respective territories, signed at London on the 23rd June, 1952, (1) and to propose that Route (2) of Schedule I to the Annex to that Agreement should be amended to read as follows: ---

In the Norwegian text:

2. Punkter i Storbritannia-Stavanger-Bergen-Oslo-Stockholm.

In the English text:

(2) Points in the United Kingdom-Stavanger-Bergen-Oslo-Stockholm.

If this proposal is acceptable to the Government of the United Kingdom, I have the honour to suggest that this Note and your Excellency's reply in that sense should be regarded as constituting an Agreement between our two Governments, which shall take effect immediately.
