The Sterling Payments Agreement between the Government of the Czechoslovak Republic and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, signed in London on the 18th August, 1949,(¹) amended by an Exchange of Notes on the 28th December, 1950,(²) extended by an Exchange of Notes on the 18th August and the 1st of September, 1955,(³) further extended by an Exchange of Notes on the 18th August and the 17th and 29th of November, 1955,(⁴) further extended by an Exchange of Notes on the 18th August and the 17th and 29th of November, 1955,(⁴) further extended by an Exchange of Notes on the 18th May and 1st of June, 1956(⁵) and further extended by an Exchange of notes on the 18th and 24th of August, 1956,(⁶) is due to expire on the 19th of February, 1957. If the Government of the United Kingdom agree to this proposal, I have the honour to suggest that the present Note and your reply to that effect shall be regarded as constituting an Agreement between the two Governments.
