

Prime Minister's Office,

My dear Sir Charles,

Amman, June 2nd, 1960.

I have the honour to refer to our recent discussion about Jordan's present financial situation and to propose that the arrangements agreed upon in paragraph 1 (b) of the Annex to the Agreement constituted by the Exchange of Notes, dated March 13th, 1957,(1) terminating the Treaty of Alliance of 1948,(2) between the Government of 15th, the Government Hashemite Kingdom Kingdom and the οf the Jordan, should be modified in such a way that payment of the third instalment of £500,000 sterling, which was due on May 1st, 1960, should be deferred until May 1st, 1966.

If the foregoing proposal is acceptable to the Government of the United Kingdom, I have the honour to suggest that the present Note and Your Excellency's reply thereto should be regarded as constituting an agreement between our two Governments in this matter.
