AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR COOPERATION ON **BETWEEN** THE USES **OF** ATOMIC **ENERGY** GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT AND THE BRITAIN AND NORTHERN **IRELAND** GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

The Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, on its own behalf and on behalf of the United Kingdom Atomic Energy Authority, and the Government of the United States of America (including the United States Atomic Energy Commission),

Desiring to amend further in certain respects the Agreement for Cooperation on the Civil Uses of Atomic Energy (hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement for Cooperation") signed between them at Washington on June 15, 1955,(1) as amended by the Notes signed October 20, 1955, and November 3, 1955,(2) the Agreement signed at Washington on June 13, 1956.(3) as modified by the Agreement signed at Washington on July 3, 1958,(4) and as amended by the Agreement signed at Washington on June 5, 1963;(5)

Have agreed as follows:

ARTICLE I

Article IV of the Agreement for Cooperation, as amended, is further amended by adding the following paragraph:

"(d) The Commission will sell to the Government of the United Kingdom in such quantities and under such terms, and conditions as may be agreed up to a net quantity of 400 kilograms of U-235 in uranium enriched in the isotope U-235 to satisfy United Kingdom requirements for fueling reactors in its civil research and development programs. This net amount shall be the gross quantity of contained U-235 in enriched uranium sold to the United Kingdom under this paragraph during the period of this Agreement less the quantity of such contained U-235 in recoverable uranium which has been returned to the Government of the United States of America or transferred to any other nation or group of nations with the approval of the Government of the United States of America during the term of this Agreement. The enriched uranium so supplied may contain more than twenty percent (20%) U-235 upon request and at the discretion of the Commission if there is a technical or economic justification in a particular case for higher enrichment."

ARTICLE II

This Amendment, which shall be regarded as an integral part of the Agreement for Cooperation, shall enter into force on the date on which each Government shall have received from the other Government written notification that it has complied with all statutory and constitutional requirements for the entry into force of this Amendment(*) and shall remain in force for the period of the Agreement for Cooperation, as hereby amended.
