*The Turkish Minister of Finance to Her Majesty's Ambassador at Ankara.*

Your Excellency,

*Ankara, March 31, 1964.*

I have the honour to refer to Articles 3 and 4 of the Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Turkish Republic concerning a Loan by the United Kingdom Government to the Turkish Government, signed at Paris on the 25th of November, 1958;<sup>(1)</sup> and also to the Exchange of Letters dated the 30th of December, 1963, concerning the postponement of the payments of capital and interest due from the Turkish Government on the 1st of January, 1964, under the above-mentioned Articles of the Loan Agreement.

I now have the honour to propose that each of the payments of interest under Article 3 and of the repayments of capital under Article 4 which fall due between the 1st of January, 1964, and the 1st of January, 1969, inclusive shall be deferred by five calendar years; and that no interest shall be payable for the five years commencing on the 1st of January, 1964.

If the above proposal is acceptable to the Government of the United Kingdom, I have the honour to suggest that the present Note and Your Excellency's reply to that effect should be regarded as constituting an Agreement between the two Governments in this matter which shall enter into force immediately.
