British Embassy,

Your Excellency,

Oslo, January 22, 1965.

I have the honour to refer to the Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Kingdom of Norway for Air Services between and beyond their respective territories, signed at London on June 23, 1952,(1) and to propose that the following Route (3) be added to Schedule I to the Annex to that Agreement:

In the English text:

(3) London and/or Newcastle-Kristiansand

In the Norwegian text:

3. London og/eller Newcastle-Kristiansand.

If this proposal is acceptable to the Norwegian Government, I have the honour to suggest that this Note and Your Excellency's reply in that sense should be regarded as constituting an Agreement between our two Governments, which shall take effect immediately.
