BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE ARGENTINE REPUBLIC EXTENDING THE MILITARY SERVICE AGREEMENT TO JERSEY AND THE ISLE OF MAN

The Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs to the Ambassador of the Argentine Republic

Your Excellency,

Foreign Office, S.W.1, 27th of November, 1967.

I have the honour to refer to the Military Service Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Argentine Republic, signed at Buenos Aires on the 12th of September, 1963.(1)

The Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland now propose that the provisions of this Agreement shall be extended, in accordance with Article 6 thereof, to persons who are or may be liable to perform compulsory military service both under the law with regard to such service in the Argentine Republic and under that in force with regard to such service in the Island of Jersey or in the Isle of Man.

If the foregoing proposal is acceptable to the Government of the Argentine Republic I have the honour to suggest that this Note and Your Excellency's reply to that effect shall be regarded as constituting an Agreement between our two Governments in this matter which shall enter into force on the date of Your Excellency's reply.
