Your Excellency,

British Embassy, Oslo, 26 July, 1967.

I have the honour to refer to the Exchange of Notes of the 12th of July, 1957(1) constituting an Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Kingdom of Norway regarding co-operation in the promotion and development of the peaceful uses of atomic energy. Under the terms of paragraph (5) thereof, the Agreement is due to terminate on the 6th of August, 1967 but may be continued in force from time to time for such periods as may be agreed between the Government of the United Kingdom and the Government of Norway.

Accordingly, I have the honour to propose that the Agreement shall be extended for a period of ten years from that date. If this proposal is acceptable to the Government of Norway, I have the honour to suggest that this Note, together with Your Excellency's reply to that effect, shall be regarded as effecting a prolongation of the Agreement until the 6th of August, 1977.

I avail myself of this opportunity to renew to Your Excellency the assurances of my highest consideration.
