Her Majesty's Chargé d'Affaires at Lisbon to the Portuguese Minister for Foreign Affairs

British Embassy,

Your Excellency,

Lisbon, 16 July, 1968.

I have the honour to refer to the Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of Portugal for co-operation in the peaceful uses of atomic energy signed at London on the 18th of July, 1958,(1) which, in consequence of Article IX thereof, will terminate on the 17th of July, 1968.

It is the desire of the Government of the United Kingdom that the validity of the Agreement be extended for a further twelve months in order to enable the co-operation between the two countries in this field to continue. I have accordingly, on instructions from Her Majesty's Principal Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs, to propose the substitution of the phrase "11 years" for the phrase "10 years" in the said Article IX.

If the above proposal is acceptable to the Government of Portugal, I have the honour to propose that this Note, together with Your Excellency's reply to that effect, shall be regarded as constituting an Agreement between the Governments which shall enter into force on the date of Your Excellency's reply.
