I have the honor to propose that the Memorandum of Understanding forming a part of the air charter services agreement between our two governments, effected by exchange of notes of March 30, 1973(1), as amended and extended by exchange of notes of March 29, 1974(2), as well as the related letter of March 29, 1974 from the Department of Trade and Industry regarding affinity charters, be further extended until May 31, 1975.

I have the further honor to propose that, if the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland accepts the foregoing proposal, this note and your reply to that effect shall constitute an agreement between our two governments in this matter, which shall enter into force on the date of your reply.
