- (a) In paragraph 2(e) of the Exchange of Notes and elsewhere, the term civilian component? - (b) Annex III, Section 6, paragraph 7, shall be amended by inserting the words "Australian or Managraph 7, shall be amended by inserting the words "Australian or New Zealand" after "United Kingdom" and
- (c) In Annex IV, Schedules I and II shall be deleted and replaced by the new Schedules I and II shall be deleted and replaced by the new Schedules I and II annexed to this Note.
