The United Kingdom High Commissioner at Lilongwe to the Minister of Finance of Malawi

Sir

1. I have the honour to refer to discussions which have taken place between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of Malawi concerning the continuance of the British Expatriates Supplementation (Malawi) Agreement 1971(²), as amended and extended by Notes exchanged at Lilongwe on 14 June 1976(³), on 28 March 1977(³), and on 18 August 1977(⁴) (hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement"), and to propose that the Agreement be further extended as follows:

In sub-paragraph 3 of paragraph 1 delete the phrase "31 March 1979" and substitute therefor the phrase "31 March 1981".

2. If the above proposal is acceptable to the Government of Malawi, I have the honour to suggest that this Note and your reply shall constitute an Agreement between our two Governments which shall be deemed to have entered into force on 1 April 1979 and which shall be referred to as "the British Expatriates Supplementation (Malawi) Agreement 1971/76 (Amendment) 1979".

I avail myself of this opportunity to renew to you, Sir, the assurance of my high consideration.
