Your Excellency.

I have the honour to refer to the agreement reached between the Delegations of Thailand and the United Kingdom during their meetings held in Thailand on various dates between 15 February-6 March 1979 and to state that I am now authorised by the Government of the United Kingdom to confirm its acceptance of the modifications of the Route Schedule of the Agreement dated 10 November 1950<sup>(1)</sup> between the Government of the Kingdom of Thailand and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland for Air Services between and beyond their respective territories, as amended,<sup>(1)</sup> and to replace it with the following Route Schedule:
