BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF KENYA AMENDING THE PUBLIC OFFICERS' PENSIONS (KENYA) AGREEMENT 1977

Sir.

I have the honour to refer to Article 7 of the Public Officers' Pensions (Kenya) Agreement 1977 signed at Nairobi on 29 March 1977. (1) and to propose that our two Governments should mutually decide in accordance with that Article that the Agreement shall be modified as follows. Subparagraph (1)(c)(iii) of Article 4 of the Agreement shall be deleted and replaced by the following sub-paragraph:—

"(iii) in respect of widows' and orphans' pensions, such stocks, funds, securities or monies as represent the interest in the Widows' and Orphans' Pensions Scheme established under Chapter 192 and the Asian Officers' Family Pensions Fund established under Chapter 194, of contributory officers and their potential beneficiaries alive on the appointed day and the beneficiaries alive on the appointed day of deceased contributory officers."

If the foregoing proposal is acceptable to the Government of the Republic of Kenya, I have the honour to propose that this Note and Your Excellency's reply to that effect shall constitute the mutual decision of our two Governments to modify the Agreement in accordance with Article 7 thereof.
