Sir,

I have the honour to refer to the British Expatriates Supplementation (The Gambia) Agreement, 1976, constituted by Notes exchanged at Banjul on 9 and 10 March 1976(<sup>1</sup>) between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Republic of The Gambia (hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement"). As a result of recent discussions between representatives of our Governments, I have the honour to propose the addition of the following institution to the list of organisations and institutions in the First Annex to the Agreement:

"Marina International School"

If this proposal is acceptable to the Government of the Republic of The Gambia, I have the honour to suggest that this Note together with your reply in that sense shall constitute an Agreement between our Governments which shall be deemed to have entered into force on 1 September 1979, and shall be cited as the British Expatriates Supplementation (The Gambia) Agreement 1976 Amendment 1979.

I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of your letter of 3 March 1980 which refers to the British Supplementation (The Gambia) Agreement 1976 constituted by notes exchanged at Banjul on 9 and 10 March 1976<sup>(1)</sup> between the Government of the United Kingdom and the Government of The Gambia (hereinafter referred to as "the agreement"). As a result of recent discussions between the representatives of our Governments, I have the honour to inform you that the addition of "Marina International School" to the list of organisations and Institutions in the first annex to the agreement is acceptable to The Government of The Gambia.

2. I therefore agree that your letter and my reply thereto shall constitute an agreement between our Governments which shall be deemed to have entered into force on 1 September 1979 and which shall be cited as the British Supplementation (The Gambia) Agreement 1976 amendment 1979.
