Excellency:

I have the honor to refer to the recent discussions between representatives of our two Governments concerning the decision of the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland to acquire the Trident I weapons system from the Government of the United States(1) and in particular concerning the manner in which such acquisition could best be implemented within the framework of United States laws and procedures applicable to sales under the Foreign Military Sales program.

I have the honor to propose, subject to such necessary technical arrangements as may be required in implementation thereof, that the Polaris Sales Agreement between our two Governments of April 6 1963(2), shall be deemed to apply as well to the Trident I weapons system and that for this purpose all references in that Agreement to Polaris shall be deemed also to be references to Trident I.

If the foregoing is acceptable to the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, I have the further honor to propose that this note, together with Your Excellency's note in reply to that effect, shall constitute an agreement between our two Governments, effective from the date of Your Excellency's note in reply.

Accept, Excellency, the renewed assurances of my highest consideration.
