L have the honour to refer to the British Expatriates Supplementation (Kenya) (Continuance) Agreement 1971/76(1) (hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement") and to propose that the Agreement be amended as follows:

- (a) in sub-paragraph 3 of paragraph 1 delete the words and figures "31 March 1981" and substitute therefor the words and figures "31 March 1986".
- (b) Delete paragraph 2(d) of Annex I.

If these amendments are acceptable to the Government of Kenya, I have the honour to propose that this Note and your reply shall constitute an Agreement between our two Governments which shall enter into force on 31 March 1981 and which shall be cited, together with the Agreement, as the British Expatriates Supplementation (Kenya) Agreement 1971/81.
