Sir

I have the honour to refer to the British Expatriates Supplementation (Malawi) Agreement 1971⁽¹⁾ as amended⁽²⁾ (hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement") and to propose that the Agreement be amended by deleting in sub-paragraph 3 of paragraph 1 the words and figures "31 March 1981" and substituting therefore the words and figures "31 March 1986".

2. I further propose that in the second annex to the Agreement all words after "University of Malawi" be deleted and replaced by:

"Schools in Malawi as mutually agreed from time to time by the Government of Malawi and the Government of the United Kingdom by correspondence".

3. If these proposals are acceptable to the Government of Malawi, I have the honour to suggest that this letter and your reply shall constitute an Agreement between the two Governments which shall enter into force on 31 March 1981, and which shall be cited, together with the Agreement, as the British Expatriates Supplementation (Malawi) Agreement 1971/81.

I avail myself of this opportunity to renew to you, Sir, the assurance of my highest consideration.
