I have the honour to refer to the Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Republic of the Philippines for Air Services between and beyond their respective territories signed at Manila on 31 January 1955(¹), as amended by the Exchanges of Notes of 7 and 14 April 1958(³) and of 14 January and 25 February 1980(³). In accordance with the discussions which took place at Manila from 27-29 April 1981, I have the honour to propose that the said Agreement should be further amended by the replacement of the Route Schedules by those set out in the Annex to this Note.

If the above proposal is acceptable to the Government of the Republic of the Philippines, I have the honour to propose that this Note and Your Excellency's reply in that sense shall constitute an Agreement between our two Governments in this matter which shall enter into force on the date of Your Excellency's reply.

Please accept, Your Excellency, the renewed assurances of my highest consideration.
