EXCHANGE OF NOTES

BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE STATE OF KUWAIT FURTHER AMENDING THE SCHEDULE TO THE AIR SERVICES AGREEMENT SIGNED AT KUWAIT ON 24 MAY 1960

The British Embassy at Kuwait to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Kuwait

Her Britannic Majesty's Embassy presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the State of Kuwait and has the honour to refer to the recent negotiations which have taken place in Kuwait on 28 October 1981 concerning the Air Services Agreement, between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the State of Kuwait, signed at Kuwait on 24 May 1960(1) as amended by the Exchange of Notes of 2 June 1963(2), 7 May 1969(3) and 25 January 1977(4).

These negotiations resulted in agreement in principle on a new Schedule, the text of which is attached as an Annex to this Note in both English and Arabic(5), to be substituted for the Schedule to the Agreement as amended.

In accordance with Article 11 (1) of the Agreement, Her Britannic Majesty's Embassy now has the honour to confirm that the revised Schedule is acceptable to the Government of the United Kingdom and to propose that, if it is also acceptable to the Government of the State of Kuwait, the present Note together with its Annex and the Ministry's reply to that effect, shall constitute an Agreement between the two Governments in this matter which shall be deemed to have entered into force on 1 November 1981.

Her Britannic Majesty's Embassy avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the State of Kuwait the assurance of its highest consideration.

SCHEDULE ANNEX

1. Route to be operated by the designated airline or airlines of the State of Kuwait in both directions:

KUWAIT--INTERMEDIATE POINTS--LONDON--POINTS BEYOND

2. Route to be operated by the designated airline or airlines of the United Kingdom in both directions:

LONDON-INTERMEDIATE POINTS-KUWAIT-POINTS BEYOND

- Note I: No fifth freedom rights shall be exercised by the designated airline or airlines of either Contracting Party on the agreed services between the intermediate points and points beyond and the territory of the other Contracting Party except as may from time to time be agreed by the aeronautical authorities of the Contracting Parties.
- Note 2: The designated airline or airlines of a Contracting Party may on any or all flights omit calling at an intermediate or beyond point provided that the agreed services on the route begin at a point in the territory of that Contracting Party.

تهدى وزارة خارجية دولة الكويت تحياتها السمى سفارة صاحبة الجلالة البريطانيه وتتشرف بأن تؤكد استلامها لمذكرتها بتاريخ ١١ ابريل ١٩٨٣ والتي نصها بالعربية كما يلي :

"تهدى سغارة صاحبة الجلالة البريطانية تحياتها الى وزارة خارجيسة دولة الكويت وتتشرف بأن تشير الى المغاوضات الحديثة التى جرت فى الكويت يوم ٢٨ أكتوبر ١٩٨١م المتعلقة باتفاقية الخدمات الجوية ، بين حكومة المملكة المتحده لبريطانيا العظمى وايرلندا الشمالية وحكومة دولة الكويت ، والستى وقعت فى الكويت يوم ٢٤ مايو ١٩٦٠ كما عدلت بتبادل المذكرات المؤرخسسة ٢ يونيو ١٩٦٣ ، ٢ مايو ١٩٦٩ و ٢٥ يناير ١٩٧٧ .

وهذه المفاوضات ادت الى اتفاق من حيث العبدأ على جدول جديد والعربية عن المحتى لهذه المذكرة باللغتين الانكليزية والعربية ، ليكون بديلا عن الجداول المعدل للاتفاقية .

ووفقا للماده رقم ١١ (١) من الاتفاقية ، تتشرف الان سفارة صاحبسة الجلالة البريطانية بأن تؤكد ان الجدول المعدل مقبول لدى حكومة المملكة المتحده وتقترح في حالة قبوله ايضا لدى حكومة دولة الكويت ، بان تشكسل هذه المذكرة مع ملحقها ورد الوزارة بذلك الصدد اتفاقية بين الحكومتين في هذا الامر والتي يجب ان تعتبر بان تكون سريان مفعولها قد بدأ من تاريخ دوفمبر ١٩٨١.

تنتهز سفارة صاحبة الجلالة البريطانيه هذه المناسبة لتعرب لوزارة خارجية دولة الكويت من فائق تقديرها واحترامها ،،،

السفارة البريطانية الكويت 11 أبريل 1487م" وتتشرف الوزارة بأن تؤكد ان المقترحات المذكوره اعلاه مقبوله لمدى حكومة دولة الكوبت التي توافق بان مذكرة السفارة مع ملحقها باللغتين الانكليزية والعربية والتي مرفقة ايضا بهذه الوثيقة وكذا هذا الرد يجب ان يشكلا اتفاقية بين الحكومتين والتي يجب ان تعتبر بأن تكون سريان مفعولها قد بدأ مسن تاريخ 1 نوفعبر 1981م •
