Your Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to the Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Yemen Arab Republic for the Promotion and Protection of Investments signed in Sana'a on 25 February 1982¹ and, in accordance with the provisions of Article 10, to propose that the Agreement shall extend to Hong Kong, the Bailiwicks of Jersey and Guernsey and the Isle of Man.

If this proposal is acceptable to the Government of the Yemen Arab Republic, I have the honour to suggest that the present Note and Your Excellency's reply to that effect shall constitute an Agreement between the two Governments which shall enter into force on the date of your reply.

I avail myself of this opportunity to extend to Your Excellency the assurance of my highest consideration.

I have the honour to refer to the agreement between the government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the government of the Yemen Arab Republic for the Promotion and Protection of Investments signed on 25 February 1982 and in accordance with the provisions of Article ten, to propose the extension of the agreement to include Hong Kong, the Bailiwicks of Jersey and Guernsey and the Isle of Man.

If this proposal is acceptable to the government of the Yemen Arab Republic I have the honour to suggest that this Note and Your Excellency's reply to it in this respect shall constitute the agreement between the two governments and shall enter into force from the date of your reply.

I avail myself of this opportunity to extend to Your Excellency the assurance of my highest consideration.

I have the honour once again to confirm to you that the proposal contained in your Note is acceptable to the government of the Yemen Arab Republic who accordingly agree that Your Excellency's Note and this reply constitute the agreement between the two governments with effect from 9 June 1985.

I avail myself of this opportunity to extend to Your Excellency the assurance of my highest consideration.
