Your Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to the Agreement of 26 October 1945⁽¹⁾ between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Union of South Africa in connection with the establishment of Civil Air Services between the United Kingdom and the Union as supplemented and amended by the exchanges of Notes of 15 September 1959⁽³⁾, 1 December 1972⁽³⁾ and 25 March 1974⁽⁴⁾ and to propose that the term "British Airways plc" be substituted for the term "British Airways" throughout the Agreement (including its Annex), as supplemented and amended.

If this is acceptable to the Government of the Republic of South Africa, I have the honour to propose that this Note and your reply to that effect shall be regarded as constituting an Agreement between our two Governments in this matter which shall enter into force on the date of your reply.

I avail myself of this opportunity to renew to Your Excellency the assurance of my highest consideration.
