Sir,

I have the honour to refer to the Overseas Service (Malawi) Agreement 1971(1) as amended(2), (hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement") and to propose that the Agreement be further amended by deleting in sub-paragraph 15 of paragraph 1 the words and figures "31 March 1986" and substituting therefore the words and figures "30 September 1986".

If this proposal is acceptable to the Government of Malawi, I have the honour to suggest that this Note and your reply shall constitute an Agreement between our two Governments which shall enter into force on 31 March 1986 and which shall be cited, together with the Agreement, as "the Overseas Service (Malawi) Agreement 1971/86".

I avail myself of this opportunity to renew the assurances of my highest consideration.
