Sir

I have the honour to refer to the British Expatriates Supplementation (The Gambia) Agreement 1976–81¹, (hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement") and to propose that the Agreement be further amended as follows:

In paragraph 1, sub-paragraph 3, delete the words and figures "31 March 1986" and substitute therefor the words and figures "31 March 1991"; and in the second annex at the end of paragraph 3 add new sentence:—

"The Government of the United Kingdom shall, after consultation with and on behalf of the Government of The Gambia, reimburse the outward passage costs directly to an agent of the Government of The Gambia within the United Kingdom."

If these proposals are acceptable to the Government of the Republic of The Gambia, I have the honour to suggest that this Note and your reply shall constitute an agreement between our two Governments which shall enter into force on 31 March 1986 and which shall be cited, together with the Agreement, as the British Expatriates Supplementation (The Gambia) Agreement 1976–81–86.
