### EXCHANGE OF NOTES BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE

# UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE PEOPLE'S DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF ETHIOPIA FURTHER AMENDING THE AIR SERVICES AGREEMENT SIGNED AT LONDON ON 7 JULY 1958

Her Britannic Majesty's Embassy to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the People's Democratic Republic of Ethiopia

Her Britannic Majesty's Embassy present their compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the People's Democratic Republic of Ethiopia and have the honour to refer to the Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the then Imperial Ethiopian Government for air services between and beyond their respective territories signed at London on 7 July 1958<sup>1</sup>, as amended by an Exchange of Notes on 30 November 1972<sup>2</sup>.

The Embassy now have the honour to propose that Note 1 in each of Section I and Section II of the Schedule to the Agreement be replaced by the following:

"1. The traffic rights to be exercised at intermediate and beyond points shall be specified by agreement between the aeronautical authorities of the Contracting Parties."

If the proposals are acceptable to the People's Democratic Republic of Ethiopia, the Embassy have the honour to propose that this Note and the Ministry's reply to that effect shall be regarded as constituting an Agreement between our two Governments in this matter which shall enter into force on the date of the reply.

Her Britannic Majesty's Embassy avail themselves of this opportunity to renew to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the People's Democratic Republic of Ethiopia the assurance of their highest consideration.
