EXCHANGE OF NOTES BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF DENMARK AGREEING TO THE INDEFINITE SUSPENSION OF THE ACTIVITY OF THE MIXED COMMISSION ESTABLISHED UNDER ARTICLE 14 OF THE CULTURAL CONVENTION, SIGNED AT LONDON ON 2 MAY 1974

The Minister of Foreign Affairs of Denmark to Her Majesty's Ambassador at Copenhagen

Copenhagen 14 August 1989

Your Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to the Cultural Convention between the Government of the Kingdom of Denmark and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, signed at London on 2 May 1974¹.

Following discussions between representatives of our two Governments I have the honour to propose that, considering that cultural relations are proceeding satisfactorily the Contracting parties should agree that, notwithstanding Article 14 of the Cultural Convention the activity of the Mixed Commission should be suspended indefinitely and the monitoring of the various cultural programmes be entrusted to the routine process of contacts between their diplomatic representatives and the appropriate ministries or institutions in each other's countries.

If the foregoing proposal is acceptable to the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, I have the honour to propose that this Note together with Your Excellency's reply to that effect, shall constitute an Agreement between our two Governments in this matter which shall enter into force on the date of Your Excellency's reply.

I avail myself of this opportunity to renew to Your Excellency the assurance of my highest consideration.
