Your Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to the Agreement relating to Civil Air Transport between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the People's Republic of China, signed at London on 1 November 1979 (hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement")¹.

In accordance with the recent discussions which have taken place between the aeronautical authorities of our two countries concerning the text of a new aviation security article, I have the further honour to propose that, under Article 17(2) of the Agreement, the existing Article 15 should be replaced by the new Article which is attached as an Annex to this Note.

If this proposal is acceptable to the Government of the People's Republic of China I have the honour to propose that this Note, together with its Annex and your reply to that effect, shall constitute an Agreement between our two Governments in this matter which shall enter into force on the date of your reply.

I avail myself of this opportunity to express to the Government of the People's Republic of China the assurance of my highest consideration.

ANNEX

Revised Aviation Security Article for Agreement Relating to Civil Transport Signed at London on 1 November, 1979

- 1. The Contracting Parties reaffirm that their obligations to each other to protect the security of civil aviation against acts of unlawful interference form an integral part of this Agreement.
- 2. The Contracting Parties shall provide upon request all necessary assistance to each other to prevent acts of unlawful seizure of civil aircraft and other unlawful acts against the safety of such aircraft, their passengers and crew, airports and air navigation facilities, and any other threat to the security of civil aviation.
- 3. Each Contracting Party shall ensure that adequate measures are effectively applied within its territory to protect civil aircraft, and to inspect passengers, crew, carry-on-items, baggage, cargo and aircraft stores prior to boarding or loading. Each Contracting Party shall also give sympathetic consideration to any request from the other Contracting Party for reasonable special security measures to meet a particular threat.
- 4. When an incident or threat of an incident of unlawful seizure of civil aircraft or other unlawful acts against the safety of such aircraft, their passengers and crew, airports or air navigation facilities occurs, the Contracting Parties shall assist each other by facilitating communications and other appropriate measures intended to terminate as rapidly and safely as possible such incident or threat thereof.

一九七九年十一月一日在伦敦签订的民用 航空运输协定中经修改的航空保安条款

第十五条

- 一、缔约双方重申,双方相互承担的关于保护民用航空安全,反对非法干扰行为的义务,构成本协定的组成部分。
- 二、缔约双方应根据要求相互提供一切必要的协助, 以防止非法劫持民用航空器的行为,以及危及此种航空器 及其旅客、机组、机场和航空导航设施安全的其他非法行 为,并防止对民用航空安全的任何其他威胁。
- 三、缔约各方应确保在其领土内有效地采取充分的措施,以保护民用航空器,并在登机或装机之前检查旅客、机组、手提物品、行李、货物和机上供应品。如缔约一方要求为处置某一具体威胁而采取合理的特别措施,对此要求缔约另一方也应给予同情的考虑。

四、当发生非法劫持民用航空器的事件,或以此类事件相威胁,或发生其他危及此类航空器及其旅客、机组、

机场或航空导航设施的安全的非法行为时,缔约双方应相 互协助,便利联系并采取旨在尽快安全地结束这类事件或 事件威胁的其他措施。
