## BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE

UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ITALY CONCERNING AN EXTENSION TO THE AGREEMENT CONCERNING COLLABORATION IN THE EXPLOITATION OF THE SPALLATION NEUTRON SOURCE ISIS FOR CONDENSED MATTER RESEARCH, SIGNED AT LONDON ON 9 OCTOBER 1989<sup>1</sup>

The Secretary of State for Foreign and Commonwealth Affairs to the Ambassador of the Republic of Italy at London

Your Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to the Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Italian Republic concerning collaboration in the exploitation of the spallation neutron source ISIS for condensed matter research, (hereinafter referred to as the "ISIS Agreement"), signed at London on 9 October 1989.

I have the honour to propose that, notwithstanding the provisions of Article 7 of the ISIS Agreement, it shall be taken to have been extended and shall continue in force until 31 December 1995.

If the foregoing proposal is acceptable to the Government of the Italian Republic, I have the honour to propose that this Note and Your Excellency's reply to that effect shall constitute an Agreement between the Governments which shall enter into force on the date of your reply.

I have the honour to convey to Your Excellency the assurance of my highest consideration.
