# EXCHANGE OF NOTES BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF KAZAKHSTAN TERMINATING THE AGREEMENT CONSTITUTED BY AN EXCHANGE OF NOTES BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNION OF SOVIET SOCIALIST REPUBLICS CONCERNING THE MUTUAL ABOLITION OF CONSULAR FEES ON VISAS SIGNED AT MOSCOW ON 13 APRIL 1964,<sup>1</sup> AS BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENTS OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND AND THE REPUBLIC OF KAZAKHSTAN

Her Majesty's Chargé d'Affaires at Almaty to the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Kazakhstan

Your Excellency

I have the honour to refer to the Exchange of Notes between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics concerning the mutual abolition of Consular Fees on visas signed at Moscow of 13 April 1964.

I would like to propose that, notwithstanding paragraph 2(C) of the said Exchange of Notes, the agreement constituted by the said Exchange of Notes be terminated as between the Governments of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Republic of Kazakhstan forthwith.

If the above is acceptable to the Government of the Republic of Kazakhstan I propose that this Note and Your Excellency's reply to that effect shall constitute an agreement between our two Governments in this matter, which shall enter into force on the date of Your Excellency's reply.

I avail myself of this opportunity to renew to Your Excellency the assurance of my highest consideration.

#### Ваше Превосходительство!

Имею честь подтвердить получение ноты Вашего Превосходительства от 31 июля 1995 года, которая гласит следующее:

Я имею честь сослаться на обмен нотами между Правительством Соединенного Королевства Великобритании и Северной Ирландии и Правительством Союза Советских Социалистических Республик относительно взаимной отмены консульских сборов за визы, подписанных в г.Москве 13 апреля 1964 года,

Я хотел бы предложить, чтобы, несмотря на параграф 2 (С), соглашение, учрежденное вышеупомянутым обменом нот, немедленно завершило срок действия между правительствами Соединенного Королевства Великобритании и Северной Ирландии и Республики Казахстан.

Если вышеупомянутое приемлемо Правительству Республики Казахстан, Я предлагаю, чтобы настоящая нота и ответ Вашего Превосходительства с этой целью учредили соглашение между нациими двумя правительствами в данном вопросе, которое войдет в силу с даты ответа Вашего Превосходительства.
