# Exchange of Notes

between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the People's Republic of China

concerning the Establishment of a Consulate-General of each Country in the other at Guangzhou and Edinburgh

Peking (Beijing), 2 September 1996

### EXCHANGE OF NOTES BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A CONSULATE-GENERAL OF EACH COUNTRY IN THE OTHER AT GUANGZHOU AND EDINBURGH

Her Majesty's Embassy at Peking to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs for the Government of the People's Republic of China

The Embassy of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland in China presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the People's Republic of China and, on behalf of the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, has the honour to propose that, with the common desire to further develop the friendly relations between the two countries, the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the People's Republic of China hereby agree to establish a Consulate-General of each country in the other as follows:

1. The Government of the People's Republic of China gives its consent to the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland to establish a Consulate-General at Guangzhou, with the consular district comprising Guangdong Province, Guangxi Zhuang Autonomous Region, Fujian and Hainan Provinces.

2. The Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland gives its consent to the Government of the People's Republic of China to establish a Consulate-General at Edinburgh, with the consular district comprising Scotland and Northern Ireland.

3. In accordance with the Vienna Convention on Consular Relations of April 24 1963<sup>1</sup> and relevant laws and regulations of their respective countries, the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the People's Republic of China shall each provide the other party with the necessary assistance for the establishment of the Consulates-General.

4. Articles 3 to 9 of the Agreement between the two Governments signed in Beijing on April 17 1984<sup>2</sup> on the establishment of Consulates-General at Shanghai and Manchester shall apply to the Consulates-General to be established under the present Agreement.

If the above agreement is confirmed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the People's Republic of China on behalf of the Government of the People's Republic of China, this note together with the reply from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs shall constitute an Agreement between the Government of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the People's Republic of China which shall enter into force on the date of the latter's reply.

The Embassy of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland in China avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the People's Republic of China the assurances of its highest consideration.

中华人民共和国外交部向大不列颠及北爱尔兰联合王国驻华大使馆致意,并谨收到大使馆一九九六年九月二日第 NO. 40/96 号照会,内容如下:

"大不列颠及北爱尔兰联合王国驻华大使馆向中华人 民共和国外交部致意,并谨代表大不列颠及北爱尔兰联合 王国政府建议,大不列颠及北爱尔兰联合王国政府和中华 人民共和国政府本着进一步发展两国之间友好关系的共同 愿望,就相互设立总领事馆事达成协议如下:

一、中华人民共和国政府同意大不列颠及北爱尔兰联 合王国政府在广州设立总领事馆,其领区范围为广东省、广 西壮族自治区、福建省和海南省。

二、大不列颠及北爱尔兰联合王国政府同意中华人民 共和国政府在爱丁堡设立总领事馆,其领区范围为苏格兰 和北爱尔兰。

三、根据一九六三年四月二十四日《维也纳领事关系公

约》和两国各自有关法律规定,大不列颠及北爱尔兰联合王 国政府和中华人民共和国政府将为对方设立总领事馆提供 必要的协助。

四、中英两国政府一九八四年四月十七日于北京签署 的在上海和曼彻斯特互设总领事馆协议中的第三条至第九 条,应适用于根据本协议设立的总领事馆。

上述内容如蒙中华人民共和国外交部代表中华人民共和国政府确认,本照会和外交部的复照即构成大不列颠及 北爱尔兰联合王国政府和中华人民共和国政府之间的一项 协议。本协议自外交部复照之日起生效。"

中华人民共和国外交部谨代表中华人民共和国政府确 认,同意上述照会内容。
