The Royal Netherlands Embassy presents its compliments to the Foreign and Commonwealth Office and has the honour to refer to the Agreement between the Government of the Kingdom of the Netherlands and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland to supplement and facilitate the Operation of the Convention of the Council of Europe on Laundering, Search, Seizure and Confiscation of the Proceeds from Crime, concluded at Strasbourg on 8 November 1990, signed at London on 15 September 1993 (hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement").

The Embassy has the honour to propose that, in accordance with Article XII of the Agreement, the application of that Agreement be extended to the Netherlands Antilles and Aruba.
