## **ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES**

The A55 Trunk Road (Slip Roads between Junction 2 (Tŷ Mawr) and Junction 6 (Nant Turnpike), Isle of Anglesey) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2011

Made	24 August 2011
Coming into force	5 September 2011

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant lengths of the London – Holyhead Trunk Road (A55) (hereinafter referred to as "the trunk road"), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

**1.** This Order comes into force on the 5 September 2011 and its title is The A55 Trunk Road (Slip Roads between Junction 2 (Tŷ Mawr) and Junction 6 (Nant Turnpike), Isle of Anglesey) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2011.

**2.**—(1) In this Order:

"exempted vehicle" ("cerbyd esempt") means any vehicle being used for the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

"the lengths of the trunk road" ("y darnau o'r gefnffordd") means those lengths of the A55 trunk road between Tŷ Mawr, Holyhead and Nant Turnpike on the Isle of Anglesey specified in the Schedule to this Order;

"works period" ("*cyfnod y gwaith*") means that period commencing at 07:00 hours on 5 September

2011 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

**3.** Subject to the provisions of article 4, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to be driven in the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

**4.** The provisions of article 3 apply only at such times and to such extent as the prohibition referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

**5.** The maximum duration for this Order shall be 12 months.
