The A470 Trunk Road (Newbridge on Wye to Llangurig, Powys) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions and Prohibition) Order 2011

8 September 2011

Coming into force

19 September 2011

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant lengths of the Cardiff – Llangurig Trunk Road (A470) (hereinafter referred to as "the trunk road"), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be restricted and prohibited by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

1. This Order comes into force on 19 September 2011. The title to this Order is The A470 Trunk Road (Newbridge on Wye to Llangurig, Powys) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions and Prohibition) Order 2011.

2.—1) In this Order:

"the lengths of the trunk road" ("y darnau o'r gefnffordd") means the lengths of the trunk road between Newbridge on Wye and Llangurig in the County of Powys specified in the Schedule to this Order;

"works period" ("cyfnod y gwaith") means that period commencing at 08:00 hours on 19 September 2011 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

- **3.** Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour, in the lengths of the trunk road.
- **4.** Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour, in the lengths of the trunk road.
- **5.** Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour, in the lengths of the trunk road.
- **6.** Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, use or permit the use of a vehicle in such a way that it overtakes any other vehicle in the lengths of the trunk road.
- 7. The provisions of articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the restrictions and prohibition referred to therein are indicated by traffic signs.
- **8.** The maximum duration for this Order shall be 6 months.

SCHEDULE

1) Garden Cottage – Argoed Hill

That length of the trunk road which extends from a point 200 metres south of the centre-point of the access road to Doldowlodd Lodge to a point 362 metres north of the centre-point of Argoed Bridge.

2) Marteg Layby and Gamallt, near Rhayader

That length of the trunk road which extends from a point 306 metres south of the centre-point of the access to Gamallt to a point 385 metres north of the centre-point of its junction with the C1216.

3) Dolhelfa Isaf and Dolhelfa Ganol, near Llangurig

That length of the trunk road which extends from a point 325 metres south-east of the centre-point of the access to Dolhelfa Isaf to a point 450 metres northwest of the centre-point of its junction with the C1218.

4) South of Neuadd-ddu

That length of the trunk road which extends from a point 94 metres north of the centre-point of the southern access of Neuadd-ddu Layby to a point 575 metres south of the centre-point of the southern access of Neuadd-ddu Layby.
