The A55 Trunk Road (Glan Conwy - Conwy Morfa, Conwy County Borough) (Temporary 70 mph Speed Limit) Order 2011

Made 19 September 2011

Coming into force 26 September 2011

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the Chester - Bangor Trunk Road (A55) (hereinafter referred to as "the trunk road"), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be restricted by reasons of the likelihood of danger to the public.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

- 1. This Order shall come into force on 26 September 2011 and its title is The A55 Trunk Road (Glan Conwy Conwy Morfa, Conwy County Borough) (Temporary 70 mph Speed Limit) Order 2011.
- 2. Subject to the provisions of article 3 no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 70 miles per hour in that length of the trunk road between Glan Conwy and Conwy Morfa in the County Borough of Conwy which extends from a point 80 metres east of the centre-point of Glan Conwy Interchange Roundabout to a point 200 metres west of the centreline of the bridge to Conwy Morfa at Conwy Morfa Interchange.
- **3.** The speed limit specified in article 2 shall be suspended if a lower limit applies by virtue of a separate temporary traffic Order.

- **4.** The provisions of article 13 of the Special Road (Glan Conwy Conwy Morfa) Regulations 1990(3) are hereby suspended.
- **5.** The maximum duration for this Order shall be 18 months.
