



3. Subject to the provisions of article 8, no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour, in the length of the trunk road.
4. Subject to the provisions of article 8, no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour, in the length of the trunk road.
5. Subject to the provisions of article 8, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along the length of the trunk road.
6. Subject to the provisions of article 8, no person shall, during the works period, use or permit the use of a vehicle in such a way that it overtakes any other vehicle in the length of the trunk road.
7. Subject to the provisions of article 8, no person shall, during the works period, ride or cause to be ridden, any pedal cycles in the length of the trunk road.
8. The provisions of articles 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the restrictions and prohibitions referred to therein are indicated by traffic signs.
9. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 12 months
