The A477 Trunk Road (Near Red Roses, Carmarthenshire and Pembrokeshire) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions and Prohibition) Order 2011

Made 10 March 2011

Coming into force 17 March 2011

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant lengths of the St Clears – Pembroke Dock Trunk Road (A477) (hereinafter referred to as "the trunk road"), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be restricted and prohibited by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

1. This Order comes into force on 17 March 2011. The title to this Order is The A477 Trunk Road (Near Red Roses, Carmarthenshire and Pembrokeshire) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions and Prohibition) Order 2011.

2.—1) In this Order:

"the lengths of the trunk road" ("y darnau o'r gefnffordd") means the lengths of the A477 St Clears – Pembroke Dock trunk road, near Red Roses, in the Counties of Carmarthenshire and Pembrokeshire described in the Schedules to this Order;

"works period," ("cyfnod y gwaith") means that period commencing at 00.01 hours on 17 March 2011 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

- **3.** Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour, in the length of the trunk road described in Schedule 1.
- **4.** Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour, in the lengths of the trunk road described in Schedules 1 and 2.
- **5.** Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, use or permit the use of a vehicle in such a way that it overtakes any other vehicle in the lengths of the trunk road described in Schedules 1 and 2.
- **6.** The provisions of the A477 Trunk Road (Red Roses, Carmarthenshire) (40 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2004(3) are hereby suspended in respect of the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order during such times as the restriction specified in article 4 is in operation.
- 7. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply during such times and to such extent as the application of the restriction and prohibition referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.
- **8.** The maximum duration for this Order shall be 12 months.

SCHEDULE 1

Extent of temporary 40 MPH & 10 MPH Speed Limits and prohibition of overtaking

That length of the trunk road which extends from a point 479 metres south-west of the centre-point of its junction with the B4314 (to Tavernspite), in the county of Carmarthenshire to a point 1.85 kilometres south-west of the centre-point of the said junction, in the County of Pembrokeshire.

SCHEDULE 2

Extent of temporary 10 MPH Speed Limit and prohibition of overtaking

That length of the trunk road which extends from a point 4.39 kilometres north-east of the centre-point of its junction with the B4314 (to Tavernspite), to a point 479 metres south-west of the centre-point of the said junction, in the County of Carmarthenshire.
