ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES

The A55 Trunk Road (Junction 8A, Carreg Bran, Britannia Bridge, Isle of Anglesey) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles and 30 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2012

Made 1 May 2012

Coming into force 12 May 2012

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant lengths of the London to Holyhead Trunk Road (A55) (hereinafter referred to as the "trunk road"), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be restricted and prohibited by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

1. This Order shall come into force on 12 May 2012. Its title is The A55 Trunk Road (Junction 8A, Carreg Bran, Britannia Bridge, Isle of Anglesey) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles and 30 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2012.

2. (1) In this Order:

"the lengths of the trunk road" ("y darnau o'r gefnffordd") means those lengths of the A55 Trunk Road at Junction 8A, Carreg Bran, in the County of the Isle of Anglesey specified in the Schedules to this Order;

"works period" ("cyfnod y gwaith") means that period commencing at 20.00 hours on 12 May 2012 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed;

"exempted vehicle" ("cerbyd esempt") means any vehicle being used for the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order.

- (2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
- 3. Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, in the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1.
- 4. Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2.
- 5. The provisions of The Trunk Road (Britannia Bridge, Gwynedd) (50 mph Speed Limit) Order 1980(3), insofar as they apply to the length of trunk road specified in Schedule 2, are hereby suspended during such times as the restriction specified in article 4 is in operation.
- 6. The provisions of The Trunk Road (A5) (Llanfairpwllgwyngyll, Gwynedd) (50 mph Speed Limit) Order 1983(4), insofar as they apply to the length of trunk road specified in Schedule 2, are hereby suspended during such times as the restriction specified in article 4 is in operation.
- 7. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the restriction and prohibition referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.
- 8. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 6 months.

SCHEDULE 1

Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles

- 1. The entire length of the westbound off slip road at Junction 8A, Carreg Bran.
- 2. The entire length of the eastbound on slip road at Junction 8A, Carreg Bran.

SCHEDULE 2

Temporary 30 MPH Speed limit

That length of the trunk road which extends from a point 900 metres west of the centre-point of Junction 9, Treborth Interchange, to the centre-point of Junction 8, Ael y Bowl Interchange.
