**ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES**

The A477 Trunk Road (West of  
Carew Roundabout to Redberth  
Junction, Pembrokeshire)  
(Temporary Traffic Restrictions and  
Prohibitions) Order 2012

*Made* 13 September 2012

*Coming into force* 23 September 2012

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant lengths of the St Clears – Pembroke Dock Trunk Road (A477) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be restricted and prohibited by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

**Title, Interpretation and Commencement**

The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

1. This Order comes into force on 23 September 2012. The title to this Order is The A477 Trunk Road (West of Carew Roundabout to Redberth Junction, Pembrokeshire) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions and Prohibitions) Order 2012.

2.—(1) In this Order:

“the lengths of the trunk road” (“*y darnau o’r gefnffordd*”) means the lengths of the A477 trunk road west of Carew Roundabout to Redberth Junction in the County of Pembrokeshire specified in the Schedules to this Order;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means that period commencing at 19.00 hours on 23 September 2012 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed;

“exempted vehicle” (*“cerbyd esempti”*) means any vehicle being used for the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

### **Prohibitions and Restrictions**

3. Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour, in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1.

4. Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour, in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1.

5. Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, use or permit the use of a vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, in such a way that it overtakes any other vehicle in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1, during such times as the restriction referred to in article 4 is in force.

6. Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to proceed in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2.

### **Application**

7. The provisions of articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the restrictions and prohibitions referred to therein are indicated by traffic signs.

### **Duration of this Order**

8. The maximum duration of this Order shall be 18 months.

## **SCHEDULES**

### **SCHEDULE 1**

#### **TEMPORARY 40 MPH AND 10 MPH SPEED LIMITS AND PROHIBITION OF OVERTAKING**

That length of the trunk road which extends from a point 253 metres west of its junction with the circulatory carriageway of Carew Roundabout to a point 200 metres east of the circulatory carriageway of Sageston Roundabout.

### **SCHEDULE 2**

#### **TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICLES**

That length of the trunk road which extends from a point 200 metres west of its junction with the circulatory carriageway of Carew Roundabout, in an easterly direction to a point at Redberth Junction, including the circulatory carriageways of Carew and Sageston Roundabouts..
