ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES

The A40 Trunk Road (Southbound Entry Slip Road at Raglan Interchange, Monmouthshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles & Cyclists) Order 2012

Made	28 September 2012
Coming into force	11 October 2012

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the Newport - Worcester Trunk Road (A40) (hereinafter referred to as "the trunk road"), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 11 October 2012 and its title is The A40 Trunk Road (Southbound Entry Slip Road at Raglan Interchange, Monmouthshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles & Cyclists) Order 2012.

2.—1) In this Order:

"exempted vehicle" ("cerbyd esempt") means any vehicle being used for the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

"the length of the trunk road" ("y darn o'r gefnffordd") means the length of the southbound entry slip road of the A40 trunk road at Raglan Interchange in the County of Monmouthshire that extends from its diverge with the A40 northbound entry slip road to its merge with the main southbound carriageway of the A449;

"works period" ("*cyfnod y gwaith*") means that period commencing at 20:00 hours on 11 October 2012 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

Prohibitions

3. Subject to the provisions of article 5, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to proceed in the length of the trunk road.

4. Subject to the provisions of article 5, no person shall, during the works period, ride or cause to be ridden any pedal cycle in the length of the trunk road.

Application

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the prohibitions referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

6. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 6 months.
