The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred on the National Assembly for Wales by sections 108(2)(b)(iii), (5), (6), (9) and (11) and 210 of the Education Act 2002(1) and now vested in them(2), make the following Order.

Title and commencement

1.—(1) The title of this Order is the National Curriculum (Assessment Arrangements on Entry to the Foundation Phase) (Wales) (Revocation) Order 2012 and it comes into force on 18 April 2012.

(2) This Order applies in relation to Wales.

Revocation

2. The National Curriculum (Assessment Arrangements on Entry to the Foundation Phase) (Wales) Order 2011(**3**) is revoked.
