**ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES**

**The A4232 Trunk Road  
(Culverhouse Cross to Capel  
Llanilltern, Cardiff) (Temporary  
Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2013**

*Made* 11 January 2013

*Coming into force* 18 January 2013

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the London – Fishguard Trunk Road (A4232) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited by reason of works being executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

**Title, Interpretation and Commencement**

1. This Order comes into force on 18 January 2013 and its title is The A4232 Trunk Road (Culverhouse Cross to Capel Llanilltern, Cardiff) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2013.

2.—(1) In this Order:

“exempted vehicle” (*“cerbyd esempt”*) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“the lengths of the trunk road” (*“y darnau o’r gefnffordd”*) means those lengths of the A4232 trunk road in the City and County of Cardiff specified in the Schedule to this Order;

“works period” (*“cyfnod y gwaith”*) means the period commencing at 20:00 hours on 18 January 2013 and

ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

**Prohibition**

3. Subject to the provisions of article 4, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to be driven in the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedule.

**Application**

4. The provisions of article 3 apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the prohibition referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

**Duration of this Order**

5. The maximum duration of this Order shall be 18 months.

**SCHEDULE**

The length of the northbound carriageway of the trunk road that extends from the start of the A4232 northbound entry slip road at Culverhouse Cross to its junction with the circulatory carriageway at Capel Llanilltern.

The length of the southbound carriageway of the trunk road that extends from its junction with the circulatory carriageway at Capel Llanilltern to the start of the southbound off slip road to Culverhouse Cross.
