# **ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES**

The A465 Trunk Road (Sale Yard Junction, Monmouthshire to Ebbw Vale Roundabout, Blaenau Gwent) (Temporary 40 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2013

Made	22 August 2013
Coming into force	1 September 2013

The Welsh Ministers, as the traffic authority for the Newport - Shrewsbury Trunk Road (A465) (hereinafter referred to as "the trunk road"), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited by reason of works proposed

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

#### **Title, Interpretation and Commencement**

**1.** This Order comes into force on 1 September 2013. Its title is The A465 Trunk Road (Sale Yard Junction, Monmouthshire to Ebbw Vale Roundabout, Blaenau Gwent) (Temporary 40 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2013.

**2.**—(1) In this Order:

"the length of the trunk road" ("*y* darn o'r gefnffordd") means that length of the trunk road, in the County of Monmouthshire, which extends

from 50 metres east of the centre point of its junction with Station Road at Sale Yard Junction to 50 metres west of the centre point of Ebbw Vale Roundabout;

"works period," ("*cyfnod y gwaith*") means that period commencing at 09.30 hours on 1 September 2013 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

# Restriction

**3.** Subject to the provisions of article 4, no person shall, during the restriction period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road.

### Application

**4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the restriction referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

# **Duration of this Order**

**5.** The maximum duration for this Order shall be 18 months.
